

EXECUTIVE SESSIONS

The Policy on executive sessions provides for exclusion of the public and press when certain personnel matters are being considered. Its also provides that the person, or persons, whose right of privacy is protected by RSA 91-A may waive such right.

1. All persons who have the choice of waiving the right to privacy, and who wish to do so, shall sign either of the following statements, whichever is applicable. *

“I understand that under the provisions of New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, Chapter 91-A, I am ensured of privacy in the matter of my _____ (a) _____ unless I waive that right. I hereby waive the right of privacy in this matter and authorize the Londonderry School Board to consider it in open session.
